



Crocheted Bow Scarf by Yvonne Metz

Scarf approx. – 40” Circumference 7’ wide
Bow – Approx 10/11 circumference & 7 ½ - 8 wide

Materials used – Red Heart SS Yarn Color of your choice
Hook size I

Notes – worked in (BLO) Back Loop Only; *ch 3 counts as first DC & ch 2 counts as 1st HDC throughout the pattern unless otherwise noted.

Scarf – Ch 142 – or until you reach the circumference above – (I crochet very tight)

Row 1 – HDC in 3rd Chain from hook and in each across (140) Ch 2 turn
(For a nice finish on the bottom of your scarf you can work your HDC in the ridge/bump of the chain)

Rows 2 – 17 – HDC in (BLO) of next HDC and in each across (140)

Cut yarn leaving a good length to sew both ends together with a whip stitch.

Bow – Ch 72

Row 1 – DC in 3rd ch from hook and in each across (70) ch 3; turn
(For a nice finish on the bottom of your bow you can work your DC in the ridge/bump of the chain)

Rows 2 – 15 – DC in (BLO) of next DC across – Ch 3 & Turn

If you wish for a wider Bow add more rows – Cut yarn leaving a good amount of length for sewing. Sew ends together with a whip stitch.

Center of Bow – Ch 10

Row 1 – Dc in 4th chain from hook and in each across (8DC) Ch3 & Turn
Rows 2 – 13 – Dc in each across (8DC) finish off leaving a good amount of yarn for sewing. Sew this piece around the Bow & Scarf.
