

Materials used:

Bulky yarn was used but a #4 weight can be used also Hook(s): G/4.0mm, K/6.5mm, L/8mm

Scarf – 2 styles

Style 1 - Crochet a chain that fits 2x around her neck turn;

R1-2: slst into each around, FO and weave in ends.

***2nd row slst in BLO

Style 2 - Infinity Scarf *Extra idea*

Ch 90

R1: Hdc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch after, ch 1 turn – 89 R2-3: BLO – Hdc x 89, ch 1 turn; FO and leave tail – sew ends

together.

Knit Look Hat — K hook for Brim; L hook for Hat *Chunky yarn was used in the pattern Brim Ch 4

R1: sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each across, ch 1 turn (3 sc)

R2: sc in BLO, ch 1 turn (3)

R3: repeat R2 til it goes around the head.

*Bring the ends together and slst them to form a circle, this is the inside of the hat. flip it around, ch 1

Hat – This hat is using the "Waistcoat Stitch" Video by Make & Do Crew https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=ibfmdMq2Zyc

R1: sc all around; slst tightly to 1st sc, ch 1 - The count will depend on how many rows you did for the brim

R2-8: you'll be working a sc in between the front posts of your sc stitch "V" – (not on the top as you normally would) **keep your tension loose See Pic below**, do this around the hat – again your stitch count maybe different join tightly with a slst; Ch 1 *Note measure around your dolls head if you need more rows keep going

Decreasing your hat -

9-11: (sc x 2, sc dec) -

SISt at the bottom of your brim and Add a Pom Pom! Weave in your ends.





^{***}depending on the yarn used you may only need 2 rows. Check it on your doll.

Katniss Messy Bun Hat - "Bonus Hat"

Ribbed Brim:

Chain 6 - **Make sure you have an even number of rows for your brim.

R1: In back loops only, sc in 2nd ch and in ea across, ch 1 turn (5 sc).

R2-56: In back loops only, sc in each st across (6 sc)

*In 1st and last stitch I went through both loops this gave me nice edging on both sides.

*if your brim needs to be bigger keep going til it's the right measurement for your doll.

*Closing the Brim - Bring both ends together and slip stitch down going through both Thicknesses. This is your seam and the inside of your hat.

The Hat

R1: Chain 2, work 60 dc as evenly as possible around edge of band. Join with slst to first dc (60 dc)

R2: Chain 2, FPDC in next stitch, BPDC in next, repeat until you reach the last stitch. Join with sl st to first FPDC

R3: Chain 1, FPSC in every stitch across, (Do not alternate like the previous row) Join by taking out your hook placing it to the back of the DC and pulling the yarn through. See Image below. Plus there is a video – Link below



R4: Chain 2, (You're working in stitches of **Previous** row) Dc in each stitch across, (This pushes the FPSC forward to give it that textured look) Join with slst to 1st Dc.

R5: Repeat R3 R6: Repeat R4

R7: Repeat R2 R8: Repeat R3 R9: Repeat R4 R10: Repeat R5

Finishing off your hat (Decrease): Ch2, (You're working in stitches of Previous row)
R1-2: - *sc in next 2 st, sc dec, repeat * all the way around join to 1st sc of each row, ch1. Finish off! I ended up with 21 stitches. You're count maybe different.
