



## The X-Over Beanie/Bun By Yvonne Metz

### Materials:

Red Heart w/Love Pewter #4

Hook: I/5.5mm

Yarn needle

Scissors

Note: Work in multiples of 4 + 1  
Chain 2 does not count as a stitch

Ribbed Brim: Chain 9

R1: Sc in 2nd chain from hook and in each chain across, ch1, turn (8 sc)

R2-69: Sc in Both Loops of 1<sup>st</sup> sc, sc BLO next 6, sc in both loops last stitch, ch1 turn, (8)

**\*If you need it longer keep going til you reach the size you need – just make sure it's in multiples of 4**

### Closing the Brim –

Bring both ends together and slip stitch down going through both thicknesses. This is your seam so it will be on the inside of your hat.

### Hat Part:

**R1:** Ch 2, work 1 DC in same st as Ch 2. Then work 68 dc (**or the count you ended up with**) evenly as possible around the edge of the band. Join with sl st to first dc (69 dc)

**R2 - 9:** Ch 2, DC in same st, sk next stitch, DC in next 3 stitches, DC in Skipped stitch, \* sk next stitch, DC in next 3 stitches, DC in Skipped stitch Repeat \*\* around, join to 1st st

My hat measured 7 ½ at this point.

### Decreasing:

R10: Ch 1, HDC in same stitch, \*HDC Dec in next 2 sts, Repeat \*, join ch 1 (35)

R11: HDC Dec, across, HDC in the last st, join, (18) you can leave as a Messy Bun here at this point. If you want a full Beanie, cut a long tail of yarn and Sew up the Opening. Add a Pom Pom or not and you are done.
