

Love Graph Beanie/Messy Bun Hat Graph by Diana Borgstrom-Breeschooten & Lynn Goulah Pattern by Yvonne Metz

Teen/Adult Size - fits 19 - 22 inch head Gauge: 5 sc stitches & 5 Rows = 2"

Materials Used:

Yarn: #5 Loops & Thread Charisma – Black/Think Pink

Hook: L/8mm Hook

Extras – Yarn Needle, Tape Measure

Stitch Abbreviations:

Ch: Chain

sc: Single Crochet

Dec: Decrease – see Special Stitches below

BLO: Back Loop Only

YO: Yarn Over sl st: slip stitch

wc: Waistcoat stitch (Knit Stitch) - see Special Stitches

V Stitch Row: see Special Stitches

Special Stitches:

Waistcoat Stich (also known as the Knit Stitch) what you are doing is basically a (SC) Place you hook in the middle of the sc below – in between the post that look like a "V" then complete as you would a sc. Make sure you are working your stitches loosely so you can get your hook in there again when you go around again.

DEC - insert hook in next stitch, pull up a loop, insert hook in next stitch, pull up a loop, go through one loop, YO then go through last 2.

Instructions:

Brim: Ch 6 (made a 2" Brim)

Row 1: sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across, ch1, turn (5 sc)

Row 2: sc in next sc, sc in BLO in next 3 sc, sc in last sc, ch1, turn (5 sc)

Row 3 - 45: Repeat Row 2 (Ended up at 17 ½")

Closing the Brim –

Bring both ends together and sl st down going through both thicknesses. This is your seam so make sure you turn it inside before you start your Hat part.

Hat Part: *Carry the 2nd color **You don't have to do the WCS


Round 1: ch 1, sc x 52 evenly & loosely all around the brim, join, ch 1 (52)

Round 2: (we main color x 2, we contrast color x 1) til last st, we main color x 1 in last st, join,

ch 1 (52)

Round 3: wc x 52, join, ch 1 (52)

Round 4-12: Use the Graph below for the next 9 rows. I carried my yarn the whole way through. (Lefty Chart is on next page)



Round 13: ch 1, work wc 52 x evenly all around the brim, join, ch 1 (52)

Round 14: (we main color x 2, we contrast color x 1) til last st, we main color x 1 in last st, join, ch 1 (52)

Round 15: wc x 52, join, ch 1 (52)

Round 16: DEC (26) – See above


Round 17-19: WCS x 26, join, ch 1 (26)

FO – Sew opening Closed and add your POM POM! You are done!

***IF you'd like to make this a MBH (I haven't tried this yet) I would do the following:

Round 18 - DEC (13) If this is to small then try alternating from wcs, then a decrease to see how the opening looks.

Round 19 – WCS x 13, join, ch 1 (13) FO
