



## Love Graph Beanie/Messy Bun Hat

Pattern by Yvonne Metz

Teen/Adult Size - fits 19 - 22 inch head

Gauge: 5 sc stitches & 5 Rows = 2"

### Materials Used:

Yarn: #5 Loops & Thread Charisma – Black/Think Pink

Hook: L/8mm Hook

Extras – Yarn Needle, Tape Measure

### Stitch Abbreviations:

Ch: Chain

sc: Single Crochet

Dec: Decrease – see Special Stitches below

BLO: Back Loop Only

YO: Yarn Over

sl st: slip stitch

wc: Waistcoat stitch (Knit Stitch)– see Special Stitches

V Stitch Row: see Special Stitches

### Special Stitches:

**Waistcoat Stich** (also known as the Knit Stitch) what you are doing is basically a (SC) Place you hook in the middle of the sc below – in between the post that look like a “V” then complete as you would a sc. Make sure you are working your stitches loosely so you can get your hook in there again when you go around again.

**DEC** - insert hook in next stitch, pull up a loop, insert hook in next stitch, pull up a loop, go through one loop, YO then go through last 2.

### Instructions:

**Brim:** Ch 6 (made a 2” Brim)

Row 1: sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across, ch1, turn (5 sc)

Row 2: sc in next sc, sc in BLO in next 3 sc, sc in last sc, ch1, turn (5 sc)

Row 3 - 45: Repeat Row 2 (Ended up at 17 ½”)

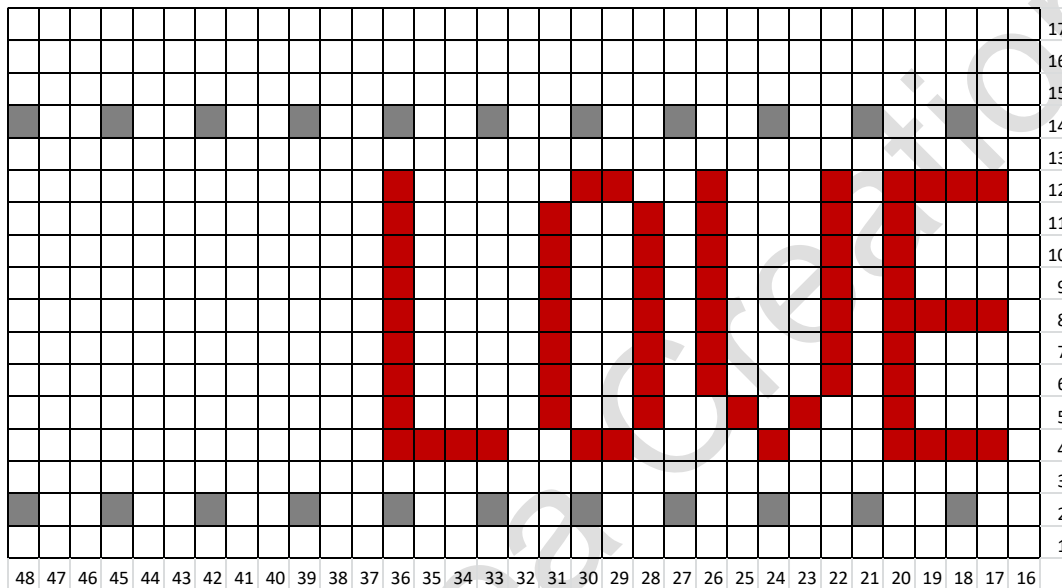
### Closing the Brim –

Bring both ends together and sl st down going through both thicknesses. This is your seam so make sure you turn it inside before you start your Hat part.

Round 4-12: Use the Graph below for the next 9 rows. I carried my yarn the whole way through. (Lefty Chart is on next page)

Round 3: wc x 52, join, ch 1 (52)

Round 4-12: Use the Graph below for the next 9 rows. I carried my yarn the whole way through. (Lefty Chart is on next page)

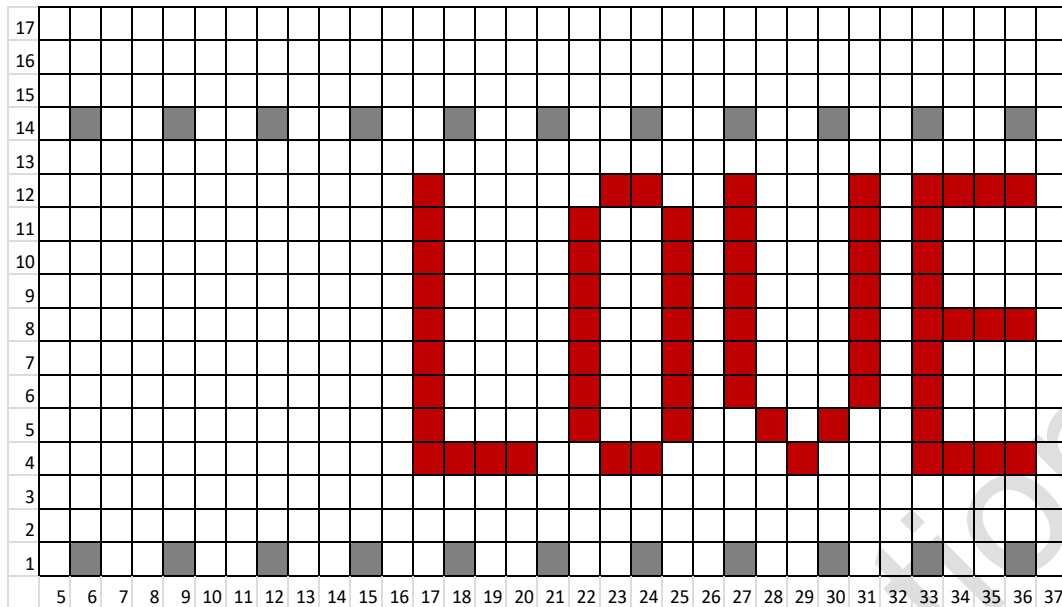


Round 15: wc x 52, join, ch 1 (52)

Round 17-19: WCS x 26, join, ch 1 (26)

FO – Sew opening Closed and add your POM POM! You are done!

Round 19 – WCS x 13, join, ch 1 (13) FO
