

Crochet Cabled Scarf

Materials used:

Yarn: #4 Red Heart w/Love (Shown Red Heart Soft)

or any #4 yarn Brand Hook: J/6.0 mm

Stitch Abbreviations:

Ch - Chain

SC – Single Crochet

DC – Double Crochet

YO – Yarn Over

Sl st – Slip Stitch

Special stitches used:

Front Post Treble Crochet (FPTC): Yarn Over (YO) twice, insert hook from front to back around post of stitch indicated. YO and pull up a loop, [YO and draw through 2 loops on hook] 3 times.

Back Post Double Crochet (BPDC): YO, insert hook behind post of stitch (insert hook from back to front of stitch), YO, pull up a loop, YO, (pull through 2 loops) twice.

Front Post Double Crochet (FPDC): YO, insert hook behind post of stitch (insert hook from front to back of stitch), YO, pull up a loop, YO, (pull through 2 loops) twice.

**CH 2 Does not count as a stitch

Directions:

Ch 25

Row 1: sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across, ch 2, turn (24)

Row 2: DC in each st across, ch 2, turn (24)

Row 3: DC in same st, FPDC in next 2 sts, BPDC in next 2 sts - **Work Cable as follows:** {Skip next 2 dc, FPTC around next 2 DC, working in the skipped stitches FPTC around 1st skipped dc then next dc} BPDC in next 2 sts, FPDC in next 2 sts, BPDC in next 2 sts, Work another Cable, BPDC in next 2 sts, FPDC in next 2 sts, DC in last st, ch 2, turn

Row 4: DC in same st, BPDC in next 2 sts, FPDC in next 2 sts, BPDC in next 4 sts, FPDC in next 2 sts, BPDC in next 2 sts, DC in last st, ch 2, turn

Row 5: DC in same st, FPDC in next 2 sts, BPDC in next 2 sts, FPDC in next 4 sts, BPDC in next 2 sts, FPDC in next 2 sts, FPDC in next 2 sts, BPDC in next 2 sts, BPDC

Row 6: DC in same st, BPDC in next 2 sts, FPDC in next 2 sts, BPDC in next 4 sts, FPDC in next 2 sts, BPDC in next 2 sts, FPDC in next 2 sts, BPDC in next 2 sts, FPDC in next 2 sts, BPDC in next 2 sts, BPDC in next 2 sts, DC in last st, ch 2, turn

Repeat Rows 3 - 6 til you get the desired length of scarf you'd like.

For the very last row SC all the way across and Finish off!
Finish it off with Fringe, Tassels or you can also Scrunch it together and add a Large Pom Pom.

NOTES:

Want to turn this into an Infinity cowl? Bring the ends together (cables facing inside) and sew ends together. Depending on the yarn you are using you might want to use a #3 worsted yarn. Which will give it that flowy feel so you can twist it around your neck.

I am not a pattern writer. So if there are any issues with this pattern please let me know.
