



Crochet Ribbed Fingerless Gloves

Materials used:

Yarn: #4 I Love this yarn in "Ocean"

Hook: I 5.5mm

Needle

Scissors

Stitches/Abbreviations used:

Ch: Chain

Sc: Single Crochet

HDC: Half Double Crochet

HDCINC: Half Double Crochet Increase (place 2 HDC in stitch indicated)

st(s): Stitch or Stitches

FO: Finish Off

BLO: Back Loop Only – means you'll be working in the back loop of your stitch.

Directions: **Note round 2-24 you'll be working in both loops of 1st & last stitch. This will give you a nice edge on both sides.

Wrist - Ch 11 – (my piece when done measured 2 ½ x 7)

Row 1: sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each around, ch 1, turn. (10)

Row 2-24: sc in 1st st, sc BLO in next 8 sts, sc in last st, ch 1, turn (10)

Bring both ends together and slip stitch across. I like to turn this part inside so it's on the inside. Now we'll be working the Hand part. CH 1

Hand Part- ***You may want to use a stitch marker to mark the last stitch once you start turning your work that way you don't miss a stitch.

Round 1: Sc in each st around, join, ch 1 (24)

Round 2: HDCINC in 1st st, HDC in each around, join, ch 1 (25)

Round 3: HDC in BLO of each st around, join, ch 1 **TURN** (25)

*****You'll be working in the BLO for the next rounds until the very end******

Round 4: HDCINC in 1st st, HDC in each around, join, ch 1, turn (26)

Round 5: HDC in each around, join, ch 1, turn (26)

Round 6: HDCINC 1st st, HDC in next 12 sts, HDCINC, HDC in last 12 sts, join, ch 1, turn (28)

Round 7: HDC in each around, ch 1, turn (28)

Round 8: HDCINC 1st st, HDC in next 13 sts, HDCINC, HDC in last 13 sts, join, ch 1, turn (30)

Round 9: HDC in next 2 sts, ch 1, skip 4 sts, HDC in last 24, join, ch 1, turn (27) includes ch 1

Round 10: HDC in each around (including the CH 1 you made) join, ch 1, turn (27)

Round 11-15: HDC in BLO around, join, ch 1 turn (27) when you reach the last round whether it's 14 or 15 Do Not turn your work unless you end on Round 14. *****if you want a shorter Glove stop at Round 14 – try it on for size.**

Round 16: SC across (no BLO) join and FO your work and weave in ends.

****If you would like to add some stitches around the Thumb part I would crochet a few rounds of single crochet stitches. Super easy and not complicated at all.**

My Finished Measurements including the wrist part was 8 $\frac{3}{4}$
